



Call for Nominations
2010 Floyd S. Oldt Award
For Exceptional Service to the University

This award was created in 1992 from a bequest by University of Nebraska alumnus Floyd S. Oldt who graduated in 1920. Mr. Oldt was a superintendent of Abel Construction Company in Lincoln before moving to Dallas, Texas, where he became a prominent general contractor. Mr. Oldt was a generous contributor to many humanitarian and civic organizations.

The Floyd S. Oldt Award was designed specifically to honor a UNL employee in a managerial/professional position. Nominees will be evaluated on:

- exceptional service and dedication to UNL;
- creativity and innovation; and
- other activities such as involvement in UAAD, participation on University committees, and community service.

The recipient of this award receives a plaque, a \$1,000 stipend and a one-year membership to UAAD.

Nominations :

Any non-faculty, regular managerial/professional employee who has been at UNL for five years or more with 50% or greater FTE is eligible for nomination. Members of the current UAAD Awards Committee and elected UAAD officers, members of the Chancellor's cabinet, and past recipients are ineligible.

Nomination Procedure:

- Submit the nomination form (attached)
- Include two letters of recommendation
- Have the person's supervisor fill out the supplemental questionnaire (attached)

The deadline to submit nominations is **February 1, 2010**. All materials must be submitted at the same time.

4. Describe incidents or give examples illustrating the nominee's exceptional ability at:
 - a. Creativity and problem-solving.
 - b. Commitment to self-development and professional growth.
 - c. Communicating effectively and resolving conflict skillfully.
5. Summarize briefly what you see as the person's greatest impact on the University community or the most significant results of this person's work.
6. Describe the nominee's involvement in activities beyond the scope of the job, including involvement in University committees or organizations, as well as activities in the community.
